Summer Season – Code of Conduct



- We expect everyone to play cricket in the right spirit and be respectful towards each other incl. your own team players, opponent and umpires.
- Any misconduct or abuse will not be tolerated which may result in disciplinary action.
- Use the ground and facilities with care
 - Clean up the ground for water/drink bottles and cans after the game (Both teams)
 - Dug out clean up after the game (Both teams)
 - Send pictures of clean-up to the Google drive folder which will be set-up for Summer.
 - Send pictures of performant players to the Google drive folder which will be set-up for Summer.
 - Make sure to keep the keys back into the lock pads after opening the grounds for all the other grounds where we have a padlock with keys.

We want to make this a good experience for all and enjoy the game.



- Game Start Rules Update
 - 7 players with Proper Uniforms to be on the field at Toss (15mins before the game)
 from each team
 - o If for any reason a team doesn't have 7 players with proper uniforms on the field, then the toss will be awarded as a win to the opponent team.
 - o If for any reason a team doesn't have 7 players with proper uniforms on the field at the start of the game, then the game will be awarded as a win to the opponent team
 - o Game must start on-time: Umpire's responsibility
 - Refer to Section 5 for more details on Match Day Readiness

Summer Season - Game Duration



- Be mindful about match duration: Umpire's responsibility
 - o T20 Match: Total 210 Minutes
 - 100 Minutes per innings
 - 10 Minutes Break
 - o 45 Overs: Total 450 Minutes
 - 210 Minutes per innings
 - 30 Minutes Break
 - Refer to Section 5 for more details on Match Day Readiness



- All 11 players should be in Colored Clothing with BACA Logo. Umpire(s) should NOT allow players to play without proper uniform.
 - Enforcement of dress code is umpire's duty
 - If umpire allows a player with improper dress code, LMC may take actions upon complaint by captains
- Colored Batting Pads Only and Umpire should ask the Batsman to correct this before allowing him to bat.
- Umpires should be in proper attire and both the team captains should make sure of this.
- Refer Section 4 for player and umpire attire on the field.
- All complaints, score correction request should be sent to <u>Summer@cricbaca.com by Monday 6 PM post game weekend.</u>
 - Only Captains and Umpires can send the complaints to BACA Committee
 - Refer to section 9, 10, 12.1
 - BACA Committee members on the ground may also file the complaints
- Replacement balls should be provided by home teams.

There are Four categories of players: Refer to Section 7 of bylaws

- 1. Youth Player (under 19 years): Can Play for any team in BACA Summer Season <u>up to 6 additional games</u> for 45 Overs and up to <u>7 additional games</u> for T20 for the entire season for other teams though NOT per team. They can play all games for the primary team which should be declared before start of the season.
- 2. Senior Player (Above 40 years): Can Play for any team in BACA Summer Season <u>upto 6</u>
 <u>additional games</u> for 45 Overs and upto <u>7 additional games</u> for T20 for the entire season NOT per team. They can play all games for the primary team which should be declared before start of the season.
- 3. Core Players
- 4. Substitute Players
- Youth and Senior players should be declared by each team before start of the season.
 - Either they are Youth or Senior
 - What is their Primary team



Open Players (With-In a Club with Multiple Teams)

- 1. This will be based on the Registration Form where we have the same club and multiple teams. If this is missed in Registration Form teams need to send an email to Summer@cricbaca.com before the beginning of the season.
- 2. If a club has 2 or more teams, then players can play in any team for a maximum of 21 games. No restrictions for the whole season for the max 21 games.



- If a player(s) does not follow the rules in terms of playing for the declared team, false identity, playing more games than allowed to name a few will be Suspended for 6months from taking part in any BACA league games or Events.
- 2. Captain and Vice-Captain will be Suspended for 6 months along with the player(s) of the offending team.



Area Critical Alliance

- 1. A Player can change his team only once before the Mid Season Cut off Date of <u>July 31st 2025</u>
 - a. Email should be sent to <u>Summer@cricbaca.com</u> to notify this change along with current and future captain.
- 2. Email should be sent to Summer@cricbaca.com to notify a change in Captaincy or Vice Captaincy with the relevant old and new Captains/Vice Captains added to the email cc. If the new Captain. Or Vice Captain being assigned doesn't agree then they should reply back to the same email with-in 48hrs showing dissent.

• Youth Player(s):

- Youth player who are of age under 19 years should be introduced by the captain after the toss to the opponent team and umpire(s).
- Captain of the team should take the responsibility of the youth player and act like a guardian for the entire duration of match to guard against excessive sledging or un-necessary aggression from the opponent team along with keeping a tab on the player when he is fielding and he doesn't do the same.





1. Delayed or Interrupted Matches:

Net run rate to be used in case the minimum overs have been played by both the teams

Forfeit/cancellation rules for games:

- In case of rain/ground availability, the game will be cancelled and points will be split.
- Refer to Section 11, 12, 20 and Table 1-1 in bylaws for penalties and fines for forfeiture

Summer Season - ByLaws

Scoring Update:

- Scoring for all games must be done on CricClubs application.
- Any scoring issues must be sent to Summer@cricbaca.com before Monday 6PM
- All Players must be added to team before the game day.
- Player cannot be added on ground in scoring application
- Scoring can only be done for claimed/registered player profiles.

Scoreboard Penalty has been taken out since last Winter. It is highly recommended for home team to carry score board

Umpiring

- Email will be send every week by Tuesday for all the games. Teams need to provide umpire names for the game. If you don't have umpires, please send an email to
 Summer@cricbaca.com for the BACA team to see if they can arrange umpires.
- Any issues related to umpiring should be sent to <u>Summer@cricbaca.com</u> by Monday 6PM following the game weekend.
- Umpiring Fee \$100/team for 45 Overs and \$50/team for T20
- Lunch: Each team to get their own lunch. Lunch for umpires will be provided by Home team.
