Winter Season – Registration, Ground & Ball Fee

- Registration Fee: \$400/team or \$600 for 2 teams to be paid by Wed **Nov 5 2025**. Failing to pay the fee will result in team disqualification for winter.
- Match Ball Fee: \$21 and 14 balls will be distributed per team a total \$294

Winter Season – Code of Conduct

- We expect everyone to play cricket in the right spirit and be respectful towards each other incl. your own team players, opponent and umpires.
- Any misconduct or abuse will not be tolerated which may result in disciplinary action.
- Use the ground and facilities with care
 - Clean up the ground for water/drink bottles and cans after the game (Both teams)
 - Dug out clean up after the game (Both teams)
 - Make sure to keep the keys back into the lock pads after opening the grounds for all the other grounds where we have a padlock with keys.
- *We want to make this a good experience for all and enjoy the game.*



Winter Season - ByLaws

- **Game Start Rules Update**
 - **7 players with Proper Uniforms to be on the field at Toss (15mins before the game) from each team**
 - **If for any reason a team doesn't have 7 players with proper uniforms on the field then the toss will be awarded as a win to the opponent team.**
 - **If for any reason a team doesn't have 7 players with proper uniforms on the field at the start of the game then the game will be awarded as a win to the opponent team**



Winter Season - ByLaws

- All 11 players should be in whites (**Collared white Shirt, Hoodies or sweater should be whites as well and Cricketing Pants with Cricketing Shoes**). Umpire(s) should NOT allow players to play without proper uniform.
- **White Batting Pads Only** and Umpire should ask the Batsman to correct this before allowing him to bat. (**Reach out to Kulwant Virdi if you need white clads**)
- Umpires should be in proper attire and both the team captains should make sure of this.
- Refer Section 4 for player and umpire attire on the field.
- All complaints should be sent to Winter@cricbaca.com by Monday 6PM post game weekend.
- Replacement balls should be provided by home teams.



Winter Season - ByLaws

There are Four categories of players: Refer to Section 7 of bylaws

1. Youth Player (under 19 years): Can Play for any team in BACA Winter Season upto 4 additional games for the entire season for other teams though NOT per team. They can play all games for the primary team which should be declared before start of the season.
2. Senior Player (Above 40 years): Can Play for any team in BACA Winter Season upto 4 additional games for the entire season NOT per team. They can play all games for the primary team which should be declared before start of the season.
3. Core Players
4. Substitute Players

- Youth and Senior players should be declared by each team before start of the season.
 - Either they are Youth or Senior
 - What is their Primary team



Winter Season - ByLaws

Open Players (With-In a Club with Multiple Teams)

1. This will be based on the Registration Form where we have the same club and multiple teams. If this is missed in Registration Form teams need to send an email to winter@cricbaca.com before the beginning of the season.
2. If a club has 2 or more teams then players can play in any team for a maximum of **18 games**. No restrictions for the whole season for the max **18 games**.



Winter Season - ByLaws

1. A Player can change his team only once and before Jan25th 2026:
 - a. Email should be send to Winter@cricbaca.com to notify this change along with current and future captain.
2. Email should be send to Winter@cricbaca.com to notify a change in Captaincy or Vice Captaincy with the relevant old and new Captains/Vice Captains added to the email cc. If the new Captain. Or Vice Captain being assigned doesn't agree then they should reply back to the same email with-in 48hrs showing dissent.



Winter Season - ByLaws

- 1. If a player(s) does not follow the rules in terms of playing for the declared team, false identity, playing more games than allowed to name a few will be Suspended for 6months from taking part in any BACA league games or Events.**
- 2. Captain and Vice-Captain will be Suspended for 6months along with the player(s) of the offending team.**
- 3. LMC may take additional penalties based on the situation.**
- 4. The above is applicable for players who did not go thru the right transfer process as indicated in by-laws section 7.4.4**



Winter Season - ByLaws

- **Youth Player(s):**

- Youth player who are of age under 19 years should be introduced by the captain after the toss to the opponent team and umpire(s).
- Captain of the team should take the responsibility of the youth player and act like a guardian for the entire duration of match to guard against excessive sledging or un-necessary aggression from the opponent team along with keeping a tab on the player when he is fielding and he doesn't do the same.



Winter Season - ByLaws

1. Delayed or Interrupted Matches:

Net run rate to be used in case the minimum overs have been played by both the teams

Forfeit/cancellation rules for games:

- In case of rain/ground availability, the game will be cancelled and points will be split.
- Refer to Table 1-1 in bylaws for penalties and fines for forfeiture
- BACA will be enforcing strict penalties for forfeiture which has both points deduction and fines.
- The team which forfeited the match, cannot play next match until the "Fine" is paid

Winter Season - ByLaws



Scoring Update:

- Scoring for all games must be done on CricClubs application.
- Any scoring issues must be sent to Winter@cricbaca.com before Monday 6PM
- All Players must be added to team before the game day.
- **Player cannot be added on ground in scoring application.**
- Scoring can only be done for claimed/registered player profiles.



Umpiring

- Email will be send every week by Tuesday for all the games. Teams need to provide umpire names for the game via updating the Sheet which will be posted in Captains WhatsApp group. If you don't have umpires, please send an email to Winter@cricbaca.com for the BACA team to see if they can arrange umpires.
- Umpire should be an active player of BACA league representation the umpiring team.
- Strict actions on Captain and Vice Captain of the umpiring team, if any umpire is found to be outside of the roster.
- Captain/Vice Captain of playing teams – Take and share a photo of umpire before game start
- No actions if playing teams fail to share umpire photo
- Any issues related to umpiring should be sent to Winter@cricbaca.com by Monday 6PM following the game weekend.
- Complaints Cannot be withdrawn after Monday 6PM post the game weekend
- All Complaints should be sent via email to winter@cricbaca.com (WhatsApp, Phone calls and other communication is NOT valida)
- **Umpiring Fee \$50/team**
